



Collaboration License

Increasingly, your organization's employees are expected to collaborate with individuals from other organizations as part of joint project teams to drive innovation and to solve problems for your customers. A key to efficient collaboration within those projects is the ability to exchange published content between team members. This can create copyright compliance challenges if all the individuals and activities aren't appropriately licensed.

A LICENSING SOLUTION FOR A CONNECTED WORLD

RightsDirect offers the Collaboration License to support these types of joint projects by enabling project team members from your company and those from another licensed organization to share published articles and other content with one another within a project-specific workgroup as part of their collaboration.

An amendment to your RightsDirect Multinational Copyright License, the Collaboration License enables joint project team members to:

- Share digital content with team members via email or a shared collaboration space for use in joint working groups.
- Store electronic copies in shared collaboration spaces for use by project team members.
- Review and exchange the latest research critical to the project.
- Use published content in support of joint project reports and internal presentations.

The Collaboration License enables the occasional, non-systematic sharing of key articles, news stories, reports and other literature between work group members that occurs in the ordinary course of a project. It does not authorize general sharing of content between all employees of the two organizations. The Collaboration License is also subject to the same general business rules as your RightsDirect Multinational Copyright License: in particular, neither the Multinational Copyright License nor the Collaboration License is meant to replace subscriptions or purchases of the content your employees and partners need as part of their ongoing daily activities.

Together, the RightsDirect Multinational Copyright License and Collaboration License reduce the administrative burden of tracking and managing content licensing and paying individual permissions, so your employees can focus on growing your business, and efficiently collaborate with confidence.


