

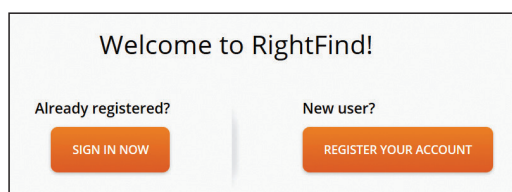
# Multinational Copyright License

## Verifying License Coverage with RightFind® Advisor

Checking coverage under your RightsDirect Multinational Copyright License is easy with RightFind® Advisor. You can check rights by journal title or standard number (such as an ISBN number) or by searching for a specific article (if enabled for your account).

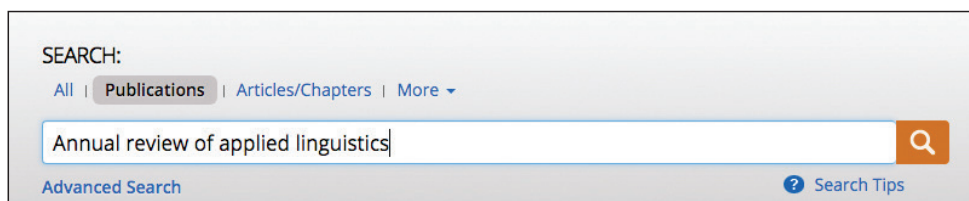
### ACCESSING RIGHTFIND ADVISOR

To access RightFind Advisor, go to <http://rightfind.copyright.com>. If you are IP authenticated on your company's network, you will see the RightFind Advisor homepage. If you are on a computer outside of your company's network, you must log in. If you are a new user, register your account with a company approved domain (This should be your professional email).



### SEARCHING FOR PUBLICATIONS

To search for a publication, go to the RightFind Advisor homepage. If you have article searching enabled, you will be able to choose whether to search by publication or by article/chapter.



- a) When searching **by title**, you can search publication title or Standard Number (ISBN/ISSN).
- b) When searching for **articles or chapters**, you can search by article/chapter title, author, or industry standard identification numbers used to uniquely identify articles and chapters (such as DOI or PMID). You can also search for keywords in the article abstract.

## VERIFYING LICENSE COVERAGE

In the search results, the most frequently requested publications are displayed first. When searching by publication title, your Multinational Copyright License coverage is shown to the right of the search results.

**Abstract:** Tasks are frequently used to elicit learner language in second language (L2) research. The purposes for doing so, however, vary widely, covering a range of theoretical models, designs, and analyses. For example, task-based researchers have examined a range of linguistic and interactional features (e.g., accuracy, language-related episodes) that are found in learner production and that vary as a function of task conditions (e.g., +/- complex), modes (oral, written, computer-mediated), and settings (second vs. foreign language). This article presents a synthesis of substantive interests and methodological practices in this area.
